**Jonathan Harris (Murray, UT)** – Mr. Harris has been employed by the Murray City Fire Department for the last 10 years. He currently holds the rank of Battalion Chief. Harris has a Master's degree in Executive Fire Leadership and is a graduate of the National Fire Academy's Executive Fire Officer program.

**Paul Nelson (DeForest, WI)** – Mr. Nelson has been the Fire Chief/EMS Director for the DeForest Area Fire and EMS District for the past three years. He previously held similar positions with North Fond du Lac and Randolph Fire Departments. Nelson has a Master's degree in Industrial Health and is a graduate of the National Fire Academy's Executive Fire Officer program.

**Danny Reynolds (Taylor, MI)** – Mr. Reynolds has spent the last 10 years with the Taylor Fire Department, working his way up to the position of Fire Chief. He was previously a paramedic with the Detroit Fire Department. Reynolds possesses an Associate's degree in Fire Science and a certificate in Fire Department Administration.
