Disposal Options for Items NOT Accepted at Hazardous Waste Collection Event

Medications (prescription or OTC)- Med Drop Locations <https://safercommunity.net/meddrop/>

Fluorescent bulbs and lamps– Dane County ordinance requires that all stores selling fluorescent bulbs and lamps must accept used lamps for recycling. Fees may be charged for small quantities from households.

Latex paint– If an inch or less is left in can, take lid off and allow paint to dry out until solid. If more paint remains in can mix with equal part clay-based cat litter, paint should harden in 10 minutes. Once hardened latex paint can be disposed of in trash. Latex paint is accepted at Clean Sweep Facility listed below.

Alkaline Batteries- Throw alkaline, single-use & other disposable batteries in trash. Some retailers will accept for a cost.

Electronics -Electronics are accepted at the Clean Sweep Facility listed below.



PREPARING FOR YOUR CLEAN SWEEP VISIT

- Package material in boxes or rigid totes to keep products upright and prevent spillage during transportation and unloading. Keep all materials in their original containers. If the container is damaged, place it in an individual plastic bag.
- **DO NOT** mix materials or co-mingle your waste in plastic bags.
- Transport gasoline or other fuels in an approved container (no larger than 6 gallons). Containers will not be returned.

YEAR-ROUND HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DISPOSAL

Dane County residents can safely dispose of household hazardous waste year-round at the Clean Sweep Facility.
