Fitchburg, WI - The City of Fitchburg is pleased to announce 2023 Healthy Neighborhood Grant Program funding awards to the following non-profit entities:

1. Aldo Leopold Elementary School Parent Faculty Organization - \$8,500
2. Badger Prairie Needs Network – \$14,000
3. Big Brothers Big Sisters of Dane County – \$15,000
4. Boys and Girls Club of Dane County – \$14,500
5. Latino Academy of Workforce Development - \$15,000
6. NewBridge Madison – \$7,500
7. River Food Pantry - \$12,000

Funding awards to be disbursed from the program in 2023 total \$86,500. These funding awards will advance the City's Healthy Neighborhoods Initiative (HNI), focusing on a variety of topics in four northern Fitchburg neighborhoods including adult education, youth mentoring, workforce development, neighborhood engagement and community-building, and food security.
