# MONTHLY UPDATE | NOVEMBER



## CALL FOR SERVICE OVERVIEW

The Department handled 1,005 citizen-generated calls for service.

Officers initiated 815 calls.

### Compared to last month:

Citizen-generated calls decreased by 9. Officer-initiated calls decreased by 153.

### Compared to last November:

Citizen-generated calls decreased by 8. Officer-initiated calls decreased by 16.

## CRIME

### PROPERTY CRIME

- Three burglaries were reported this month.
- Three vehicles were reported stolen this month.

### SHOTS FIRED/GUN-RELATED CRIME

- One shooting was reported this month and one shots fired was reported this month.
- Two firearms were seized as evidence this month.
- Two robberies involving a gun were reported this month.

### DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

Officers investigated eleven domestic violence incidents this month.

## OTHER NOTABLE EVENTS

### INCIDENTS, INVESTIGATIONS, AND ARRESTS

**Armed Robbery Suspect Arrest | 11/14** | Officers located a suspect from an October armed robbery and took him into custody. A search warrant was executed at the apartment he had come out of and a firearm was recovered. The 26-year-old male was booked into the Dane County Jail for a violation of his probation. Armed robbery and felon in possession of a firearm charges were referred to the Dane County District Attorney's Office. Charges for multiple incidents of passing counterfeit currency were also referred.

**Armed Robbery Suspect Arrest | 11/20** | Detectives located a suspect from a different October armed robbery incident at an apartment complex and took him into custody. A search warrant was executed at two apartments connected to the suspect in the complex. A hidden firearm and narcotics were located in one of the apartments. The 18-year-old was booked into the Dane County Jail for a warrant for a probation violation and a warrant for armed robbery from the October incident.

## MONTHLY UPDATE | NOVEMBER



**Shooting | 11/20** | A man was shot in an apartment complex parking lot off of Anton Drive after he attempted to purchase a cell phone through Facebook Marketplace. He was transported to a hospital with non-life-threatening injuries.

On 11/22, a search warrant was conducted at a home in the Village of Oregon and an 18-year-old suspect was taken into custody. He was booked into the Dane County Jail for a probation violation. Charges for the shooting and attempted robbery have been forwarded to the Dane County District Attorney's Office. The investigation remains open and active.

**Stolen Vehicle Suspect Arrest | 11/21** | While on patrol, an officer observed a male wearing clothing that matched a suspect seen in a video of a theft from a vehicle incident. The officer contacted the male and learned he was a 16-year-old who had been arrested in October after being found getting out of a stolen car and in possession of a stolen gun. When he was contacted this time, the male was in possession of a BB gun that resembled an actual firearm. He admitted to stealing the BB gun out of a car in Madison. He also admitted to stealing the same car twice earlier in the month from an address on High Ridge Trail. The 16-year-old was transported to the Juvenile Reception Center on charges related to the vehicle theft and BB gun theft.

### COMMUNITY EVENTS

**Stuff a Squad** | Records specialists staffed two squads, parked at Pick 'N Save and Hy-vee, to collect over 1,000 pounds of food for the Allied Food Pantry.

**Berbee Derby** | Officers assisted in traffic control and course safety and security for over 6,100 runners and walkers on Thanksgiving Day.

**Future Quest** | Sergeant Brown and CSO McCauley attended Future Quest, a career exploration event for thousands of middle school students held at the Alliant Energy Center.

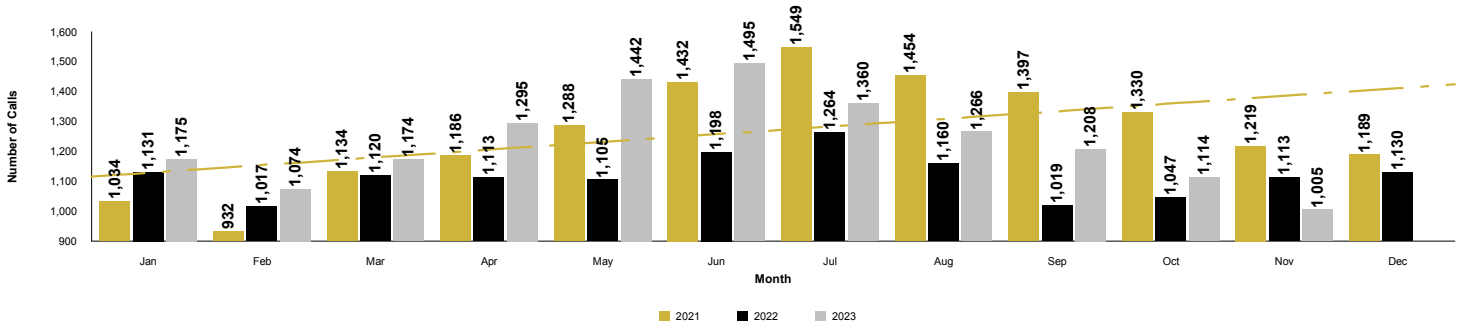

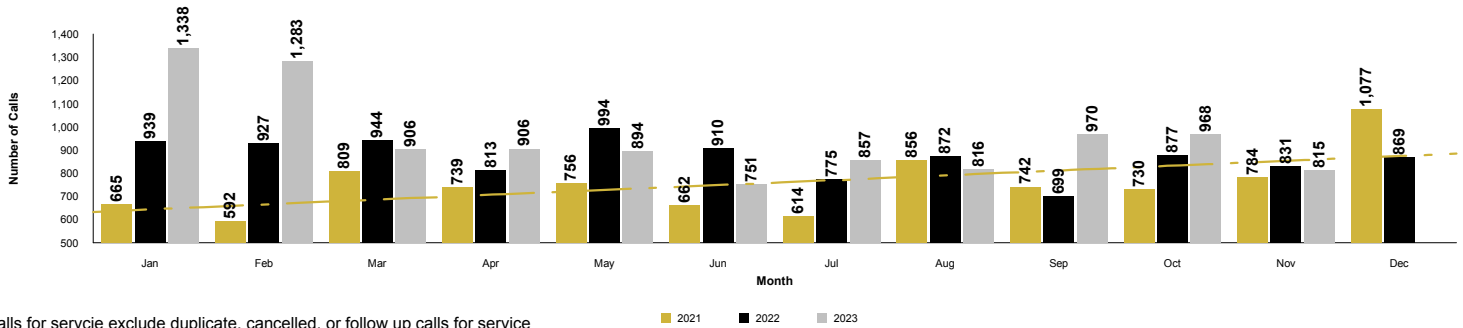
