MONTHLY UPDATE | JANUARY



CALL FOR SERVICE OVERVIEW

The Department handled 1,076 citizen-generated calls for service.

Officers initiated 1,025 calls.

Compared to last month:

Citizen-generated calls increased by 98. Officer-initiated calls increased by 270.

Compared to last January:

Citizen-generated calls decreased by 99. Officer-initiated calls decreased by 313.

CRIME

PROPERTY CRIME

- Four burglaries were reported this month.
- Three vehicles were reported stolen this month.

SHOTS FIRED/GUN-RELATED CRIME

- There were no shootings or shots fired reported this month.
- Three firearms were seized as evidence this month.
- No robberies involving a gun were reported this month.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

Officers investigated nineteen domestic violence incidents this month.

OTHER NOTABLE EVENTS

INCIDENTS, INVESTIGATIONS, AND ARRESTS

Shots Fired Suspect Arrest | 1/5 | Officers located a suspect from a December shots fired incident and took him into custody. A search warrant was executed at two locations he was associated with and a firearm and drugs were recovered. The 35-year-old male was booked into the Dane County Jail and charges of felon in possession of a firearm, first degree recklessly endangering safety, and first degree attempted intentional homicide charges were referred to the Dane County District Attorney's Office.

Strangulation and False Imprisonment | 1/5 | Officers were dispatched to the report of a domestic incident. A victim reported being pushed, strangled, and held against their will by their partner. Ultimately, a 26-year-old male was arrested and booked into the Dane County Jail on a probation violation. Charges for strangulation, false imprisonment, battery, and criminal damage to property were referred to the Dane County District Attorney's Office.

MONTHLY UPDATE | JANUARY



OWI – Employee Injury | 1/8 | Officers were dispatched to a motor vehicle accident and upon arrival located a subject who had crashed into a parked car. The investigation revealed the suspect, a 45-year-old male, was highly intoxicated. While attempting to take the suspect into custody, the suspect resisted and caused injury to an officer’s thumb. The suspect was booked into the Dane County Jail on charges of OWI 2nd and resisting an officer. The officer was treated and released from a local hospital for their injury.

Drug and Weapon Arrests | 1/29 | Officers were dispatched to the report of subjects using drugs in a vehicle in an apartment complex parking lot. Upon arrival, four occupants were removed from the vehicle where a firearm was located in one of the subject’s waistbands. A subsequent search of the vehicle yielded large quantities of drugs, several cell phones, and a large amount of cash. Ultimately, an 18-year-old male was booked into the Dane County Jail on charges of bail jumping and possession of Fentanyl with intent to deliver and another 18-year-old man was booked into the Dane County Jail on carrying a concealed weapon charge.

Sexual Assault: Adult | 1/24 | The Fitchburg Police Department took a report of a sexual assault where a female victim was reporting a male performed nonconsensual sexual intercourse on her. After further investigation and interviews, investigators developed probable cause to arrest the male for 2nd degree sexual assault.

On 2/9, a warrant was executed at an apartment in Middleton, belonging to the suspect’s brother. The sexual assault suspect was located and arrested during the search warrant. While executing the warrant, guns and drugs were visible in the apartment. A search warrant was then drafted, signed, and executed to obtain the evidence. Three firearms, large amounts of drugs, and \$10,000 was seized as a result of the search warrant. Ultimately, the suspect’s brother was booked into the Dane County Jail on charges of felon in possession of a firearm and felony bail jumping. The suspect of the sexual assault was also booked into the Dane County Jail on charges of 2nd degree sexual assault, 3rd degree sexual assault, and felony bail jumping.

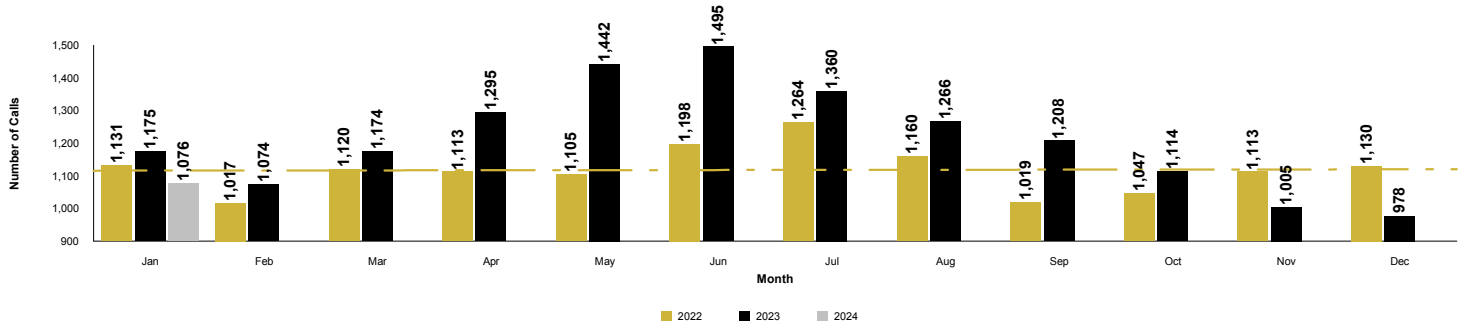

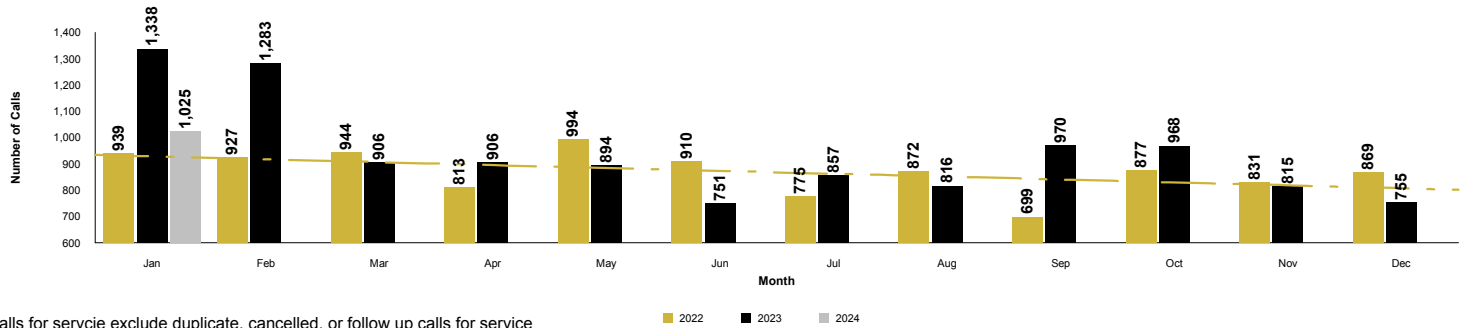
