Funding awards to be disbursed from the program in 2024 total \$138,000. These funding awards will advance the City’s Healthy Neighborhoods Initiative (HNI), focusing on a variety of topics in four northern Fitchburg neighborhoods including adult education, youth mentoring, workforce development, neighborhood engagement and community-building, and food security.
