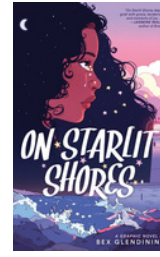


Huda F Wants to Know?

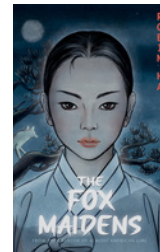


Young Hag and the Witches Quest

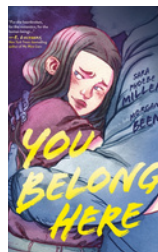


We Could Be Magic
